

McDonald Road Hawks Pathfinder Waiver

Assumption of Risk and Commitment Form

The World Health Organization has identified Covid-19 as a worldwide pandemic. It is currently understood to be highly contagious, primarily spread through person-to-person contact and airborne droplets. In accordance with federal, state, and local government agencies, and conference and church recommendations, the McDonald Road Pathfinder Club leadership has drafted protective measures to reduce the spread of this virus. These measures are subject to change, to remain in compliance with the above-named agencies. Updates will be sent to parents through the email addresses given at registration. The measures include the following:

Weekly Meeting Protocol:

- Masks and physical distancing will be required for both indoor and outdoor activities.
- In lieu of opening ceremonies (falling in), Pathfinders will go directly to their unit classrooms and have worship/opening ceremonies there.
- Pathfinders will remain in their respective classrooms until parents arrive to pick them up. Dismissal is at 8:30 pm.
- If a parent wishes to remain in the gym during Pathfinders, he/she must wear a mask and maintain physical distancing. Non-Pathfinder siblings must stay with their parents (not playing in the gym) and follow the same protocol (masks/proper physical distancing).

Campouts:

- Transportation: All staff children will ride to campouts with their parents. Masks and physical distancing will be required for Pathfinders riding the bus. Parents are welcome to drop off and pick up their child(ren) from campsites, if desired.
- Tents: We will work with parents to designate tent assignments, potentially putting siblings together, or close friends who have maintained exposure to one another. Hammocks are an option for those of high-school age. Pathfinders may also stay in their own tents.
- Food: Food will be served to Pathfinders, and units will have staggered meal times to minimize contact and maintain social distancing.

These measures are intended to be protective; they do not guarantee that your child(ren) will not become infected with Covid-19. We ask that parents assume the following responsibilities:

Parental Responsibilities:

- Check your child's temperature before leaving your house for Pathfinder meetings and/or campouts.
- Keep your child home if:

- He/she has had any exposure to an individual who has Covid-19 or is under quarantine for exposure.
- Is exhibiting any of the following symptoms: fever, chills, cough, sore throat, respiratory illness (*even if it is thought to be allergies or a cold*), loss of taste or smell.

By signing this consent, I acknowledge that I have read and agree to the terms outlined above, and that I have reviewed them with my child(ren). I acknowledge the risks associated with my child(ren)s involvement with Pathfinders, and voluntarily assume the risk that my child(ren), and through them, my family, may be exposed to or infected by Covid-19 during our weekly meetings and campouts.
